Alderman Morrow made the motion to accept the proposal from HRL for emergency debris removal as the lowest and best proposal provided and to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a contract with HRL Contracting, Inc., for the same which is appended hereto, with the unit price per cubic yard as proposed, and to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute related documents included a Notice to Proceed, seconded by Alderman Corley, and upon unanimous vote the motion carried.

## 4. AUTHORIZE EMERGENCY RENTAL OF CHIPPER FOR DEBRIS REDUCTION
